STREET PARKING

The parking ticket procedure is the following: (72 hour process) Each violation must be witnessed by the officer personally. The ticket may be issued for prolonged parking, parking on the wrong side of the street, abandonment and inoperable vehicle.

After 24 hours a warning is issued with marking of tires

Another 24 hours a ticket is issued

Another 24 hours and the vehicle is towed at the homeowner's expense.

PARKING ON THE GRASS

When witnessed by the officer, a ticket may be issued but must be personally signed by the owner of the vehicle. This vehicle may not be towed from private property. The security patrol officer will call the management company after they witness this violation 2 times and the deed restriction violation letter process will begin.
